## **Pryor Cashman's Real Estate Group Selected for Inclusion in The Legal 500 – Real Estate**

Pryor Cashman's Real Estate Group have been selected for inclusion in *The Legal 500 – Real Estate*. Partners Ronald Kremnitzer and Wayne Heicklen, Co-Chairmen of Pryor Cashman's Real Estate Group, as well as Eric Woldenberg, Chairman of Pryor Cashman's Tax Group, also received special recognition.

Kremnitzer, Heicklen and Woldenberg, along with Pryor Cashman's Real Estate Group in general, were nominated by corporate counsel as being among the leading real estate lawyers in the United States. The publication notes that "[c]ombined with about five litigators active in the real estate market, the practice focuses on representing entrepreneurs in the real estate world, development and leasing work for large retailers, and high-end residential real estate work – apartments bought in New York at the \$20m level."
