Pryor Cashman Partner Jeffrey Johnson Quoted In E-Commere Times About Microsoft's Vista Problem

Pryor Cashman partner Jeffrey Johnson, who specializes in the transactional aspects of technology and intellectual property exploitation, was quoted extensively in a June 21, 2007 article in *E-Commerce Times* entitled “The Vista Problem: Can Microsoft Fend Off Another Legal Onslaught?” The article by Erika Morphy concerns the complaints which Google had made against Microsoft’s latest operating system, Vista, and Microsoft’s announcement that it would make changes to the system to satisfy Google’s concerns.
